Meeting was called to order at noon by Chairman Bill Richards at the Pickaway County Annex, 141 W. Main St., Suite 400, Circleville, Ohio.

- B. Reading of previous month Minutes (<u>approve/amend</u>) Andi Humphries: Correct Financial to "December" Balance and add "approximately" to amount from Ohio History Connection. Hartinger motioned approval of corrected minutes, Fields seconded, motion carried.
- C. Financial status of Park District: The balance at the end of January is: \$58,417.86. Exact amount from Ohio History Connection is \$2,375 and notation from Auditor states it's from Knox County Park District. Hess made a motion to accept the treasurer's report, Sorvillo seconded, motion carried.
- D. Guests: Cynthia Bower is observing. She also stated she walked the Towpath trail which could use directional signs. The board explained that new signs will be incorporated with the change of ownership.

Rod Smith said the Ohio History Connection was at the park on that day with an Archeologist using radar to detect any buried historical artifacts. It will be plotting a map of the park of which a copy will be given to the board.

John Drummond gave the board his application and paperwork for the Zero Turn mower through South Central Power. He also reminded the board of the April 14 community action day at OCU. He will apprize Davis of number needed and chores by the March meeting.

E. Director's Report

1) Leadership Sub Committee Meeting: recommendation on park levy: Mike Hess said it's the recommendation that the board seek a levy on the November 2017 ballot because there won't be a lot on at that time. The committee realizes it could cost \$30,000. If unsuccessful could review feedback and submit again for the May Primary the following year at a lower cost of about \$1,000. After discussion, Hess motioned that he prepare a resolution for the board's consideration to place a Parks and Trails Levy on the Nov.

2017 ballot for 10 year, ½ mill; based on final recommendation from county prosecutor and city law director. Sorvillo seconded; motion carried.

The establishment of a "Friends of the County Parks and Trails" group was discussed. The Leadership committee will develop a framework for this group as well as the group which would ask for funds to help offset the levy costs.

- 2) Rules Sub Committee meeting; recommendation on Park Rules. Fields and Hess met with Drummond and Davis and presented the attached document. Sorvillo motioned to accept Resolution 001-2016 "Park Lands Rules", Hartinger seconded; motion carried. It was decided that the upper and lower gates be open and the boat ramp be locked. The shelter house will be by reservation or first come/first served basis.
- 3) Judge Long memo reference to Canal Park: The law requires formal approval of the probate judge before accepting property. A memo was signed by Chairman Richards asking the judge for the correct way to get this approval.
- 4) Columbia Gas Easement: Hess has asked for \$1,000 more for both tracks and is waiting for a counter offer from Roy Strawser, negotiator for Columbia Gas.
- 5) Parks and Trail Grant Applications: The applications have been sent to townships and villages and are due April 8.
- 6) Consultant's invoice: Sorvillo motioned that the 2/23/16 invoice be approved for payment, Hess seconded; motion carried.
- F. Unfinished Business: Hartinger asked about the Palm/Elsea land. Davis said it is on hold since Elsea is reviving a development in the area.

Roundtown Trail: The easement issue with the Circleville City Schools has been resolved and should be rectified by the end of February. The construction documents can continue at that time.

G. New Business: Drummond asked that Davis send a letter to Reeser about the mowing of his adjoining property. Richards said his employee who has been mowing the trail land has stage 4 lung cancer.

Canal Leak: engineers have looked at the south end of the towpath trail and recommend that it is best to let nature take its course. May have to close the trail at the curve.

Moore asked about designing new park board logo. Humphries volunteered to help.
